WANADA's Interpreter Access Program offers free interpreter services to people from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds while they attend alcohol and other drug services with our member agencies.

How Does It Work?

- Interpreter services need to be booked either through the Translating and Interpreting Service (TIS National), or through another suitable interpreter service
- Keep in mind longer sessions may be needed
- Interpreting services provided during the session may be accessed face to face or via telephone
- Interpreting service invoices are sent to WANADA to cover the costs
