### HIGHLIGHTS

The 2023 Aboriginal Alcohol and Other Drug Workers Forum: Time for Action was attended by over 200 delegates from all regions in Western Australia, and received positive feedback 96% indicating the forum was useful.

The 2023 Forum aimed to strengthen and develop culturally responsive approaches to addressing alcohol and other drug related harms, allowing workers and community members to share and learn about service models and programs, to build professional networks, to discuss common issues, and to plan action that will have a positive impact in communities throughout WA.

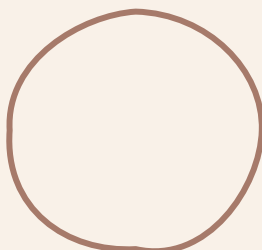

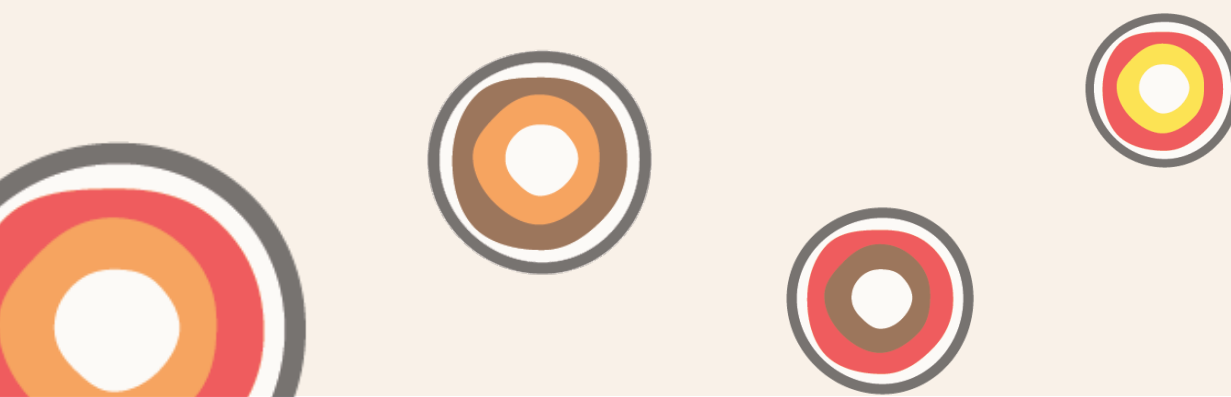
